Once you have been diagnosed with glaucoma, your eye doctor will have prescribed you eye drops that help reduce the pressure in your eyes.² Now you can also add COQUN® to your daily eye care routine.¹ COQUN® does not reduce the pressure in the eye. COQUN® has been researched and developed to work alongside the drops you have been prescribed for glaucoma.¹

Retinal ganglion cells are spread throughout the back of the eye and join to form the optic nerve which connects to the brain.³ These cells are the signalling cells, connecting the eyes to the brain, they are affected in glaucoma and COQUN® works to protect them.⁴

Many cells in your body generate new cells as old ones die. For example, the cells that make up your hair, skin and nails are constantly renewing themselves. However, the Retinal Ganglion Cells in your eye are different, they are not replaced by new ones when the old ones die – so they need looking after.⁵

COQUN® helps by providing additional CoQ10 directly to the eye, which may help to protect the Retinal Ganglion Cells.⁶⁻⁸ This protection may come from the additional energy production and through CoQ10's antioxidant properties.⁹⁻¹¹
