Please consult their timetable on line and double check when there as they do change. They have a very good on line booking system for the ferry with the prices that vary from \$35 to \$40 per person one way or double for both ways. Bags are usually \$3 per bag , and they do ask you to check even small airline carry on bags.

Earliest ferry is 8.25 then usually one or two at lunchtime and one in the afternoon.



If you get a ferry to Road Town it is an extra 20 minute taxi journey to LongBay and obviously the ferry takes longer too. Thus West End ferry is the quickest route.

Jon or the taxi firm will meet you at either port of course.

Price \$35 one way or \$60 round trip. They do an airport to ferry to Tortolla all inclusive package for \$86 round trip.

On Tortola our ferries all dock in Road Town (RT) but i St. Thomas some of our erries dock in Charlotte Amalie (CA) and some dock in Red Hook (RH). Please consult our schedule and be sure to select the proper ports for your departures and destinations.
