Director and founder of Clinica London, ophthalmic and oculoplastic surgeon Jane Olver, has also been a consultant ophthalmologist with the Imperial NHS Healthcare Trust which is closely linked to Imperial College since 1994.

Alongside her general ophthalmology work, her private practice expanded, first via several local hospitals and then through the Harley Street Oculoplastic Clinic where she shared premises with other ophthalmic specialists at number 73 Harley Street for six years.

As her reputation grew - first through patient recommendations, the publication of many papers and books

and appearances at international conferences - she moved forward with her ambition to open a bespoke private clinic where all eye problems and some aesthetic rejuvenation treatments could be carried out in a unique welcoming and professional environment.

"I wanted to create an ultra-clean but not sterile environment. Somewhere where it would be both a pleasure to work and also somewhere pleasant and relaxing for my patients", said Jane.

Two floors at 140 Harley Street were chosen as the location for Clinica London. These premises were then refurbished by the acclaimed architect Jerry Bailey and the doors opened to patients in January 2011.

Since the opening of Clinica London, Jane gradually reduced her time working as an NHS consultant at the Western Eye Hospital and at the Charing Cross Hospital.

A pivotal turning point occurred in August 2012 when Jane started a two sabbatical from the NHS in order to concentrate on developing this first class private Eye Clinic, Clinica London, and in order to have time for personal development and to enjoy her family. She looks forward to taking Clinica London forwards and providing patients with rapid access to first class general and specialist eye care.
