Mr Duguid graduated in medicine from Aberdeen University and trained in ophthalmology in Glasgow, Melbourne, London and Paris. He was registrar and senior registrar in Moorfields Eye Hospital and then subspecialised in vitreo-retinal surgery as a fellow at Moorfields and Hospital Lariboisiere in Paris. He was appointed to the Western Eye Hospital (Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust) as a consultant in 2001. He is Lead Clinician at the Western Eye Hospital.

He specialises in medical and surgical diseases of the retina and ocular trauma, retinal disease includes retinal detachment, macular hole, epiretinal membrane and advanced diabetic membrane peels. Mr Duguid is also able to offer small-gauge vitrectomy.

He is a Consultant adviser in Ophthalmology to the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) and holds regular clinics at their headquarters in Gatwick. He is also a Designated Aviation Ophthalmologist to the Civil Aviation and Safety Authority of Australia (CASA) and sits on the Vision Panel for the Department of Transport.
