She has a special interest in vitreoretinal conditions such as retinal detachment, macular hole, epiretinal membrane, retinal tears, diabetic retinopathy, vitreous haemorrhage and vitreomacular traction and in medical retinal condition such as Age-related macular degeneration, retinal vein occlusion, and all stages of diabetic eye disease from diagnosis and screening for retinopathy, laser and intravitreal injection treatment to vitreoretinal surgery for advanced diabetic eye disease.

Rahila's research is focused on novel treatments and diagnosis of macular holes, vitreomacular traction, ocular trauma and the management of medical retinal disorders. Her expertise is demonstrated by the wide variety of national and international invitations. She is currently Principal Investigator for studies on Ocriplasmin for vitreomacular traction and macular holes.
