Professor Philip Bloom began training at The Bristol Eye Hospital, then in London at The Western Eye Hospital and at Moorfields Eye Hospital, where he underwent a Glaucoma Fellowship. He specialises in Glaucoma, Cataract and Anterior Segment Surgery and holds a joint consultant appointment between The Western Eye Hospital (Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust, London) and The Hillingdon Hospital (Uxbridge).

Professor Bloom's clinical and research interests include Trans-scleral and endoscopic cyclophotocoagulation, Combined cataract and glaucoma surgery, and Spectacle independence following cataract surgery (including multifocal lens implantation, toric IOLs and incisional refractive surgery).

He is a close colleague of Mr Lee having worked at Hillingdon and the Western Eye Hospital almost as long as Mr Lee. He is one of the country's most eminent consultants of glaucoma and specialises in advanced surgical and laser treatments.
